

Quick Draw Impromptu Prep Suggestions

ONE MINUTE PREP TIME

Here's one way to approach it:

- ★ Do you have a personal story?
- ★ What does it mean in your own words?
- ★ Why is it important to the audience?

Another approach:

1. Introduction

Start your speech with something to capture your audience's attention. Remember people like to think about themselves. Share the prompt and a strong opinion.

2. Supporting points

Use a story and examples to support your strong opinion.

3. Conclusion

Try to tie the conclusion back into your introduction if possible.

DURING YOUR 2 MINUTE SPEECH

- ★ Move! (just not backward)
- ★ Use gestures.
- ★ Find places to smile.
- ★ Make eye contact with the WHOLE ROOM (just for this event).
